
## Water Supply Update If it Rains and if it Doesn't

Early winter storms meant the watershed was primed to absorb additional rain. However, January, February and March, normally the wettest months, were extremely dry.



A series of early winter storms primed the watershed for maximum inflow to the lake. By contrast, small, light rain events resulted in little to no runoff.














Years of strategic investment in a robust and diverse water supply portfolio combined with exceptional conservation by customers means the Goleta Valley is well positioned whatever the weather brings.
